

Wikipedia.org - Online Notability Guidelines


Wikipedia.org remains one of the most reputed sources of editable content in the world.

Within hours of posting content on Wikipedia, it can be indexed in Google and Yahoo!

However, the editorial guidelines are very strict and it is critical to understand that editors police postings.

It is vital to have "reliable secondary sources" as references in any Wikipedia.org posting to ensure it survives the human editorial test.
